

Goals of the journal:

high-level studies in the field of regional analyses, to encourage the exchange of views and discussion among researchers in the area of regional researches.

Overview of the peer-reviewing process

After receiving a study the Editor-in-Chief decides on whether to start the peer-reviewing process.

If the Editor-in-Chief considers the study to be suitable for peer-reviewing, then he sends it for peer reviewing by two peer reviewers. The journal maintains double anonymity, so neither the peer reviewers nor the author(s) can be identified by one another (peer reviewers can be members of the editorial board or other recognized professionals of the particular area).

The Editor-in-Chief summarises the opinions of peer reviewers, on which basis he makes his first decision on the study (acceptance, request for reviewing, rejection) and sends it to the author. The study reviewed by the author is then examined by a peer reviewer making a comparison, chosen from the members of the editorial board. She/he looks for the answer to the question to what extent the reviewed study reflects the opinions of the peer reviewers? She/he submits her/his comments to the Editor-in-Chief, who goes on inviting the author to review the article if he deems it necessary.

The Editor-in-chief, on the basis of the proposal of reviewers and the opinion of the editorial board, decides on the publication of the final article.
